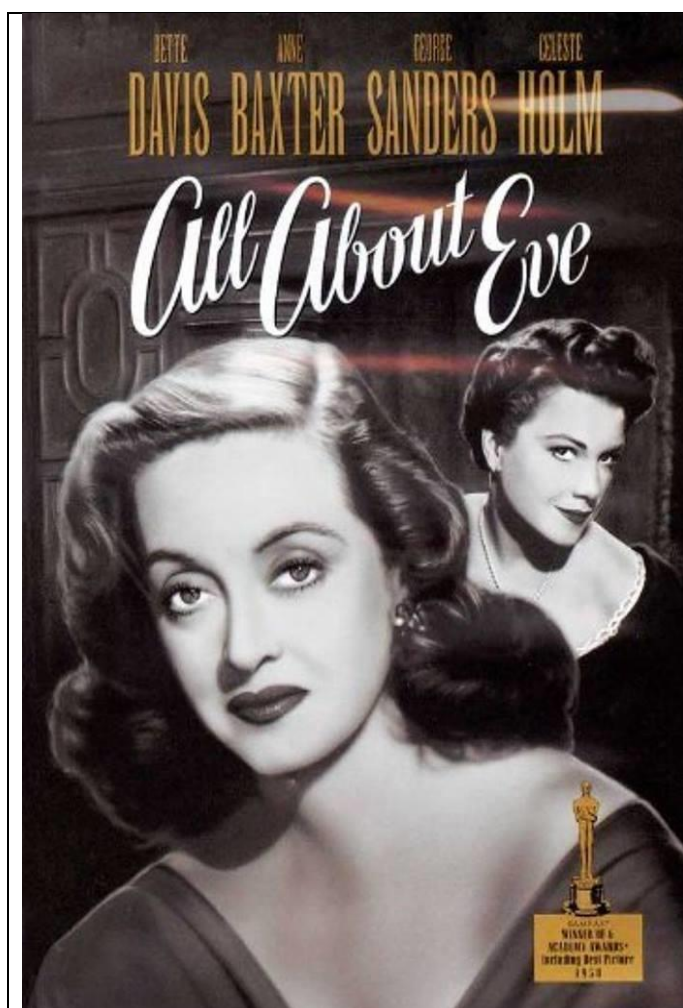

American Movie Night: *All about Eve*

Narva Central Library American Space and the U.S. Embassy film series.

All About Eve is a 1950 American drama film written and directed by Joseph L. Mankiewicz, and produced by Darryl F. Zanuck. It was based on the 1946 short story "The Wisdom of Eve" by Mary Orr, although screen credit was not given for it.

Praised by critics at the time of its release, *All About Eve* received 14 Academy Award nominations and won six, including Best Picture. *All About Eve* is the only film in Oscar history to receive four female acting nominations (Davis and Baxter as Best Actress, Holm and Ritter as Best Supporting Actress). *All About Eve* was selected in 1990 for preservation in the United States National Film Registry and was among the first 50 films to be registered. *All About Eve* appeared at #16 on AFI's 1998 list of the 100 best American films.

Media Literacy Workshop at Narva America Space

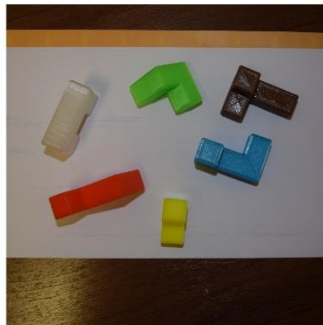
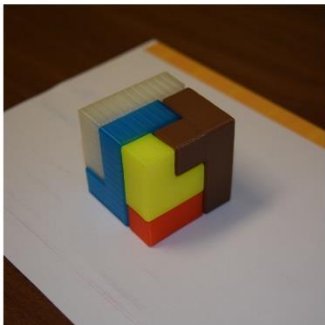
Themes: NEW VALIDY, Spread of misinformation, E.S.C.A.P.E, Critical thinking.

American Club

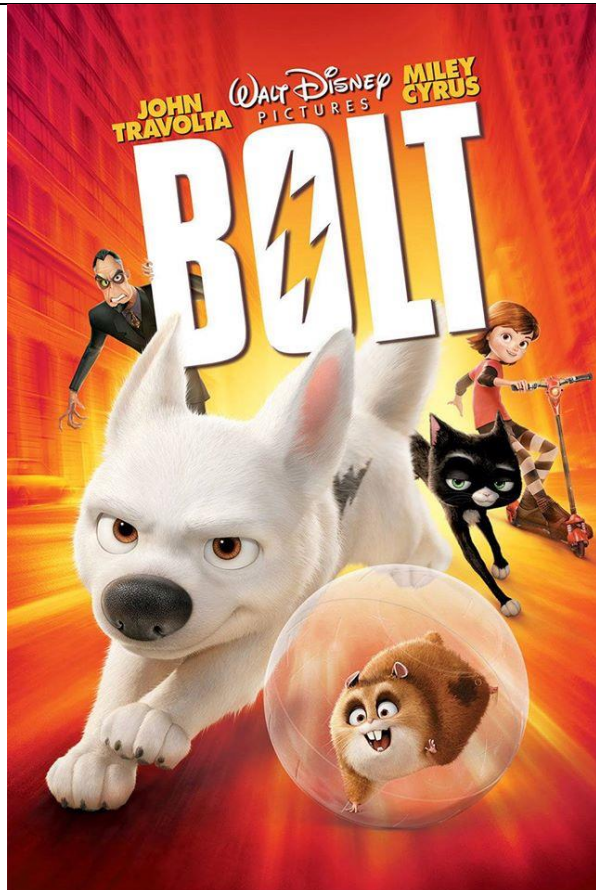

Bolt is a 2008 American computer animated comedy-adventure film produced by Walt Disney Animation Studios and released by Walt Disney Pictures. It is the 48th Disney animated feature film. Directed by Chris Williams and Byron Howard, the film stars the voices of John Travolta, Miley Cyrus, Malcolm McDowell, Diedrich Bader, Nick Swardson, Greg Germann, Susie Essman and Mark Walton. The film's plot centers on a white dog named Bolt who, having spent his entire life on the set of a television series, thinks that he has super powers. When he believes that his human, Penny, has been kidnapped, he sets out on a cross-country journey to "rescue" her.
